

Dr Suresh Kumar Verma has made outstanding contributions in horticultural research and extension. He has collected a total of 1520 germplasm in different horticultural crops such as fruits (960), vegetables (320), ornamentals (82) and others (158) in 38 exploration trips (13 from Arid zone, 24 from Temperate zone and 01 from NEH). He has generated more than 05 lakh quality planting material of Kiwi, Uttaranchali Kagzi Nimbu, Rosemary and others and supplied to growers. He has identified superior genetic stock of Uttaranchali Kagzi Nimbu (frost resistant), Uttaranchali Kaku, Uttaranchali Hisalu, Uttaranchali Hajiri, Strawberry (large fruit & better keeping quality), Rudraksh, Pahari Nimbu (good eye catching appeal with high yield), Giloe (high tinosporanin & medicinal value), Uttaranchali Chow Chow (large size without prickles).
