Dr Suresh Kumar Malhotra has made outstanding contributions in horticultural research and extension. His major focus is on increasing production and productivity of agricultural crops through implementation of National Food Security Mission, National Mission for Oil Seeds, Mission for Development of Horticulture and increasing water productivity through PMKSY. He has developed 14 high yielding varieties of seed spice crops, many of which are now basis of cultivation in Rajasthan and Gujarat under rainfed farming system. He was visiting scientist at Cornell University Ithaca, USA & worked in USAID project of value chain management and at Taiwan Agri. Research Institute, Fengshan. He represented India in G 20 meeting of agriculture chief scientists at Moscow & Uzbekistan, Israel, Saudi Arabia, CODEX-CCFFV meeting in Thailand, Mexico. He also represented India in SAARC, FAO, WHO, UNECE, CODEX, IDC, ADB, African Union, European Union meetings. He was chair to 18 high powered committees & task forces to provide solutions to challenges.
