Dr Brij Lal Attri has made outstanding contributions in horticultural research and extension. He worked on various tropical, sub-tropical and temperate horticultural crops including under-utilized fruits and spices. He worked on postharvest management and value addition of temperate horticultural crops including *Rhododendron*, ginger and various under-utilized and less known fruits in Uttarakhand and has initiated work on postharvest management, storage and value addition of different mushrooms. The varieties of apple and garlic released by him have been adopted on a large scale in hilly areas. He has also been awarded as *Best Technocrat Award-2014* by EET-CRS, Noida for his work on *Rhododendron* and ginger blended squash. He has standardized various technologies and postharvest products from different tropical, sub-tropical and temperate fruits.
